"A charmer from the Soljans family, which has been making wine for three generations at Kumeu, near Auckland. An asti spumante lookalike that's enticingly sweet, rich, bubbly, fresh and deceptively easy to drink. Chill well and use as an aperitif or with desserts." Warren Barton

Made from 100% Muscat grapes grown in Gisborne This wine is fragrantly perfumed and lively, with a delicate alcohol, a refreshing sugar/acid balance and plenty of floral concentrated sweet flavours.

Winemakers Notes

Controlled cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks after crushing and pressing help retain the fresh fruitiness that this wine imparts. Good to drink young or cellar for 2 years.
